Dr Reil, can Ulthera really help with wobbly neck, sagging jowls, eyelids, and crows feet “without surgery”?

Dr Reil Hard to believe, but proven — an Ulthera treatment will not cut or disturb the surface of the skin at all, yet will treat the deepest support layers of the skin creating new and stronger collagen and elastin. That is why results happen gradually over a six-month period as the (collagen-building layer) tone of the deepest connective tissue layer continues to improve over time. This deep treatment was never possible before without surgery.

Who is a candidate for Ulthera?

Dr Reil Just about anyone! Men and women who have mild-to-moderate face, brow, or neck sagging. These are the candidates that will see the most dramatic results. For those with severe sagging, it cannot replace cosmetic surgery but they too would see some improvement with Ulthera. The oldest patients I have treated are in their 80s, and they have seen good results.

How does the treatment work, how much downtime is there afterwards, and, of course, does it hurt?

Dr Reil The procedure takes about 90 minutes depending on which area(s) of the neck and face the patient elects for the procedure. A wand is placed on the area that very precisely directs micro-focused ultrasound waves to these deepest (collagen) connective tissue layers. For some, the procedure can be mildly uncomfortable. The sensation is temporary — like a prickly, stinging sensation while the ultra sound is being delivered — but there is no lasting discomfort.

Upon completion, most people can return to activities immediately with no visible sign of the procedure having been done. A small percentage may experience a slight, temporary redness for up to an hour after the procedure and some tingling or tenderness to the touch for a day or two.

Is Ulthera treatment safe?

Dr Reil The procedure is FDA-approved and demonstrated safe in clinical studies. Over 500,000 treatments have been performed worldwide, and I am proud to say that I am the Premiere Provider of Ultherapy in the nation, having provided nearly 1400 treatments since November. My patients have been very happy with the results.



What other possibilities are there for ways for Ulthera to help?

Dr Reil I am working with Ulthera in developing expanded applications, including abdominal toning, upper breast lift, and correction of unilateral facial tone in patients with facial asymmetry, such as after a stroke.
